**Directive 2002/95/EC
RoHS – Substances dangerous**

Dear Madam, dear Sir,

regarding the application of the directive 2002/95/EC we inform you as follow:

Our company is not producer of the sold products. Our suppliers confirmed us that the products delivered to you are corresponding to the directives 2002/95/EC.

The elements of lead (except lead alloyed products), of mercury and of cadmium are absent in steel and non-ferrous products. On the other hand the scrap and the alloy may contain traces of these elements. Especially during the melting process these trace elements cannot be excluded.

The trace elements must not be declared on the certificat of the material and in general these are under the detectable limit during analyses. According to the statements of our suppliers, the trace elements are between 1 and 50 ppm per element..

The lead Steel products with up to 0.35% of lead, the aluminium products with up to 0.4% of lead and the Copper alloyed products with up to 4% of lead are accepted by the appendix of the directives (Art. 4, §1 Exceptions) and authorised in the future without limitation.

For steel products the Cr⁺⁶, PBB and PBDE are not applicale, because they don't exist in the melted and in the solid material. The supplier of non-ferrous products confirms also the absence of the substances Cr⁺⁶, PBB and PBDE.
